#### **Committee Updates**

**Academic Affairs Rep (P. Jensen):** No Report

**Student Affairs Rep (A. Bangura):** Triton College is working to use Everfi as an online training platform for students. Everfi has a wide range of prevention education and compliance training curriculum that can be used for both students and staff. The platform will allow Triton College to deploy training, communicate with learners, track completion and access data insights.

**Human Resources Committee (J. Klinger):** H.R. is preparing for employee group in service days and compiling a list of groups of people or individuals for the retirement and recognition ceremony. The ceremony will be held on April 30<sup>th</sup> 2020.
