### Arts & Sciences:

Dr. Sheldon Turner has just returned from a <u>STEMSEAS</u> expedition across the Pacific Ocean. This
is Dr. Turner's second expedition with the program, which provides ship-based science
experiences for undergraduate students.

### **Business and Tech:**

- A new program assistant Mia L. Castillo has been hired for the Criminal Justice Administration and the Computer Information Systems departments.
- HVAC program has officially started its first summer class on July 1st with 14 students, which is at full capacity

### Continuing Education:

- Youth summer camps are underway with a majority at 90-100% capacity.
- The PEPA Academy (ICCB Grant)— both a Healthcare and a Manufacturing/Industry cohort kicked
  off on May 28. The 60-hour, 5-day-a-week training programs were completed on June 25 with a
  hiring event and completion ceremony. Nine businesses came in, and each student interviewed
  with two employers. On June 24, we hosted a "Professionals Night," where ten professionals
  from various industries came in to talk with students about their career journeys, their

industries, and the prospects for future employment. Overall, a total of 23 students completed the program. The completion rate is 92%.

 From the Manufacturing/Industry cohort, 5 of the 14 students have enrolled in certificate programs through WEI. In Healthcare, two students are enrolling in sonography for the Fall, and others are considering other areas of training.

#### **Health Careers:**

- Barbering/Cosmetology: progress is being made and furniture is arriving. Currently on track for Fall opening.
- A number of new faculty have been identified, selected, and onboarded in respiratory care, nursing, surgical technology, and still searching for a CNA chair along with many adjunct faculty.
- Started interviewing for an administrative assistant to fill one vacancy.
- There are updates to the nursing webpage in progress.

### Adult Education:

- Completion Ceremony was held on Thursday, June 5 for the GED/ESL Completers.
- 75 GED Graduated this year, which is 50% increase from FY2024.
