Transferring Ideas into Scientific Discoveries

At Triton College, students are learning across life sciences and physical sciences with the opportunity to actively conduct innovative research. With Triton's state-of-the-art classrooms and lab facilities, students are diving into real-world scientific exploration – transforming scientific ideas into discoveries.

Dr. Sheldon Turner, chair of Triton's Science Department, said the college's Physical and Life Science Undergraduate Student Lab – known as the PLUS Lab – provides students with the right tools and guidance to conduct university-level research.

With the PLUS Lab, students “have a chance to conduct quality research in their first years of college, where at a four-year university they would need to wait until their junior or senior year and compete for positions in a lab,” said Dr. Turner.

“There is a stigma that community colleges don't do research because we only teach introductory courses, but all of (Triton's) faculty were researchers at one point in their career,” said Dr. Turner, adding that most faculty in Triton's Science Department “have PhD research degrees and are excited to mentor students.”

Dr. Turner served as a mentor for Andrew Ek, a student majoring in geology. Thanks to an X-ray fluorescence analyzer – an instrument not used in a typical classroom – Ek was able to perform research on limestone, an ancient rock that formed millions of years ago. According to Dr. Turner, XRF technology “lets us measure the exact amount of an element in any substance we test, such as rocks, soil, food or metals.” This technology is made available at Triton's PLUS Lab.

Following his research, Ek presented his study – “Comparative biogeochemical analysis of modern tufa and Ordovician dolostone source utilizing X-ray fluorescence spectroscopy” – at the 2024 John S. Albazi Student Research and Creative Activities Symposium held at Northeastern Illinois University (NEIU).



In describing the study, Dr. Turner said northern Illinois is covered with limestone “from back when the state was a tropical coral reef near the equator. There are quarries all over Illinois, where this rock is mined to be turned into cement and concrete for our roads and buildings.”

Ek was searching through one of these quarries for these ancient marine fossils and came across a strange rock called Tufa, which forms in fresh water instead of the ocean, said Dr. Turner.

“Upon closer inspection, this Tufa was full of seeds, bugs and material that appeared to be modern (less

than 100 years old). We studied the fossils of the limestone and the objects in the Tufa to confirm their ages and then used the XRF to study the chemical differences between the two rocks.”

Ek’s research would normally require “a university lab and isn’t something many community college students would ever have access to without something like the PLUS Lab,” said Dr. Turner, who co-authored the article, *The Benefits of Empowering Community College Geoscience Faculty in Eos*, a science magazine of Advancing Earth and Space Sciences (AGU).

In addition to Ek, Triton biotechnology students Alexandra Csercse, Sasha Spain, Gennevieve Garcia, Michael Elyafi, Diana Zapata and Jeffrey Capilli, mentored by Triton instructor Dr. Gabriel Guzman, also presented at NEIU. The title of their presentation was “Artificial Sweeteners Do Not Induce Adipogenesis in The Absence of Proadipogenic Inducers in 3T3-L1 Cells.”

The students set out to investigate the effects of the most common sweeteners used in the United States, according to Dr. Guzman. With Triton’s biotech lab, “we researched cells when introduced to these sweeteners and if they accumulate fat. We found that these cells do accumulate fat,” said Dr. Guzman. “However, we found that there was no difference between artificial and normal sweeteners.”

“It took a lot of trial and error,” said microbiology student Michael Elyafi. “We eventually found our answer.”




