Academic Support

The Board of Trustees received a presentation about embedded academic support including Peer Mentoring and the Virtual Navigator Program.



Virtual Navigators are assigned to online courses to support and coach students transitioning to online learning by helping them navigate the Blackboard course platform, and also connect them to college student support services and community resources.

The PMC is a classroom-based peer mentoring program. Mentors attend class sessions, host weekly office hours for tutoring, facilitate study sessions, and connect students to campus resources.
