

## CLEP - College Level Examination Program Information

The College Level Examination Program (CLEP) offers students the opportunity to bypass undergraduate coursework saving money and time, while still achieving their academic goals. CLEP is the most widely accepted credit-by-examination program used to assess college-level knowledge obtained through prior learning and life experience. More than 2,900 colleges and universities award college credit for passing CLEP scores.

Qualifying scores may vary by institution and exam. Candidates are encouraged to check with their credit-granting institution to verify that the exam will meet their curriculum needs.

## **REGISTRATION AND ON-CAMPUS SCHEDULING**

Taking a CLEP exam requires a CLEP registration ticket and an appointment at the Triton College Testing Center. To obtain a registration ticket create an account at <https://clep.collegeboard.org/register>. Registration tickets expire 6 months from the date of purchase. To schedule an appointment with The Triton College Testing Center visit <https://triton.edu/testingcenter>. Most CLEP exams are 90 minutes in length.

## **EXAM FEES**

Candidates must make two payments to take a CLEP exam:

- \$93 per title (paid in advance on the CLEP website link above)
- \$20 per title (payable on test day to Triton College by cash, credit card, check, or money order)

## **ON YOUR TEST DAY**

**Candidates must bring their CLEP registration ticket, \$20 test administration payment, and one form of valid photo identification** in order to be admitted for testing. The identification must be government-issued, current, must bear the test-taker's full name in English language characters, and must contain a recognizable photograph with a signature.

High school or home-schooled students under the age of 21, if you do not have the required government issued ID, please visit the CLEP website at <https://clep.collegeboard.org/test-day> to complete a Student ID Form. This form is valid for one year and must be accompanied by a recognizable photo and a school or notary seal overlapping the photo. The form must be signed in front of a school official or notary.

Please arrive 15 minutes before your scheduled appointment, and report directly to the Testing Center, Room A-126. You will be given directions on how to make your \$20 payment prior to sitting for your exam.

## **TEST SCORES/REQUESTING CREDIT**

Candidates will receive immediate test results by viewing their unofficial score report at the end of their testing session, except exams with required essays. Essay scores are available to test takers one to two weeks after the test date.

**In order to earn credits at Triton College for your qualifying CLEP score you must be a current student enrolled in credit classes. Additionally, the Testing Center must receive an official score transcript directly from CLEP, and the candidate must fill out a general petition.** When registering for the exam online indicate Triton College as the score recipient. General petitions can be obtained from the Testing Center in A-126.
