### Program Prerequisites

### Prerequisites listed below must be completed before the start of the program.

Must hold active status with the American Registry of Radiologic Technologist (ARRT) or certification with the Nuclear Medical Technology Board or with ARRT, Nuclear Medicine Registry examinations.
Must have graduated from an accredited program by the Joint Review Commission on Educational Program (JRCNMT or JRCERT) in the past five years for admission OR if graduation is longer than five years, Must complete BIS240 (Human Anatomy & Physiology 1)

\**All prerequisite coursework must be completed with a grade of "C" or better.* \**All test scores must be within the last two years.* 

*Health Insurance Requirement for Clinicals:* All students enrolling in a Health Career Program must have current Comprehensive Health Coverage to attend clinicals. If you need coverage, please review the following options (<u>Student Insurance Plan, Discounted Health Services</u>. Please ensure you have the required coverage before proceeding.

<u>Healthcare background checks with NO record of misdemeanor or felony, drug testing and physical exams are</u> required. Full disclosure is required regarding hits on background checks. Refer to the website for details on the <u>Diagnostic homepage.</u>

1 extra point for PHY100 (General Physics) or DMS100 (Introduction to Imaging Physics) with C or better

\_\_\_\_\_1 extra point HTH281 or American Healthcare Association CPR - Basic Life Support (BLS) and First Aid for Health Care Providers
