Diagnostic Medical Sonography Degree Program Details

The diagnostic medical sonographer provides patient services, using diagnostic ultrasound under the supervision of a physician responsible for the use and interpretation of ultrasound procedures. The sonographer assists in gathering sonographic data necessary to reach diagnostic decisions.

Diagnostic Medical Sonography (ultrasound) is one of the most recent and fastest-growing medical specialties. Graduates are employed in medical centers and hospitals. The goal of this program is to prepare competent entry-level sonographers in the cognitive (knowledge), psychomotor (skills), and affective (behavior) learning domains.

The General DMS Program sponsored by Triton College is accredited by the Commission on Accreditation of Allied Health Education Programs (www.caahep.org) upon the recommendation of the Joint Review Committee on Education in Diagnostic Medical Sonography.

Degree Prerequisites:

- Must read and write at college level; can be demonstrated by course equivalency, or by meeting all current reading and writing requirements for completion of RHT101
- PHY100 (General Physics) or DMS100 (Introduction to Imaging Physics)
- MAT110 (College Algebra) or MAT111(Pre-Calculus) or MAT124 (Finite Math) or MAT131(Calculus)
- BIS240 (Human Anatomy and Physiology I)
- AHL120 (Comprehensive Medical Terminology)

*Completion of the Allied Health, Math and Science prerequisites must not be more than 5 years old. All prerequisite coursework must be completed with a grade of "C" or better.
