Wester replied that since D. Manni stated there are no full time faculty for this area, we may need to proceed with a course-to-course articulation. J. Murphy stated that items 19-263 and 19-265 will be tabled to the November meeting. S. Campos suggested to D. Manni to review how other 296 courses are written as an example, to complete the topics and outcomes. J. Murphy added that the topics and learning outcomes would be general, not specific.

J. Murphy stated that there is no time for further discussion. K. Li stated that he has collected information from other schools and we need to find time to draft forms (application). J. Murphy stated that we must plan a timeline for meetings, as we need to communicate the new Credential and its purpose to the students, Student Services, Marketing, etc. D. Carter asked if this will be completed this semester. K. Li replied yes and that he would like to offer in Spring 2020. S. Campos stated that it would be approved and definitely ready with all the approvals to offer for Fall 2020. K. Li suggested that Summer 2020 could also be an option and asked how would we record this Credential, as part of the AA Degree or as separate code. M. Flaherty added that we need to be careful how it is marketed and what is the intent of this Credential. L. Wester stated that the Credential would not be filed for graduation. J. Murphy questioned if these students are to be part of completion, wouldn't they need to petition for graduation? L. Wester replied 'No'. P. Zinga stated that currently the system recognizes completion of the I.A.I. Core and can ID the GECC Credential courses. S. Misasi Maratto stated that the new Credential would need to be added to the Catalog, since it is approved by the ICCB. K. Li would check with the ICCB for suggested language. He added that the Credential would be modeled from the AA Degree and he is looking into possibly modeling the AS Degree. J. Davidson added that this Credential would be submitted as a Reasonable and Moderate Extension of the AA Degree. K. Li will call the ICCB for clarification. J. Murphy will call a meeting this Fall. R. Segovia added that would be this semester. S. Campos stated that we need to plan ahead. L. Wester added that the new Dean of Student Services should start this month. S.
