HOW DO I DROP A CLASS?

Talk to your advisor about deadlines for dropping classes. Your advisor can also help you explore the pros and cons of your decision. Withdrawing from a class may impact your financial aid or athletic eligibility. Check with those departments or an advisor before withdrawing from a class.

If you wish to withdraw from a class after regular registration, you must withdraw officially by contacting the Welcome Desk prior to the withdrawal deadline or by withdrawing from the course in your <u>MyTriton Portal</u> → Student Self Service Tab→ Click on Registration→ Drop Button under each course.

Students are responsible for officially withdrawing from their course(s).
